What is the Displaced Livelihoods Initiative?

A research initiative that will generate and share new evidence to inform policies and programs that can foster sustainable livelihoods for displaced and host communities.

- Partnership between Innovations for Poverty Action (IPA) and Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL), formally launched in April 2023
- Supported by the IKEA Foundation

What do we want to learn?

Thematic focus

Unpacking the impact of policies and programs designed to further **sustainable livelihoods**

Priority areas for learning:

- Resilience
- Wage employment
- Entrepreneurship
- Social cohesion, inclusion, and norms
- Rights and regulations

Sample research questions

- What is the impact of **skills accreditation and certification** on the labor market access of displaced populations?
- What are the impacts of displaced businesses on **local value chains,** and how can positive impacts be maximized?
- What strategies can be employed to foster a **sense of belonging** among displaced people in new locations, and is this a pathway to economic inclusion?
- How can **regularization programs** that provide access to social services and the right to work augment economic outcomes and decrease negative coping strategies?
