Pledge commitments will support the implementation of and advocate for inclusive legal and policy frameworks to promote economic inclusion and social protection, including through policies and programmes needed to reduce the lifelong consequences of poverty and exclusion.

Pledge commitments will be evidence-informed and supported by relevant programmes, technical assistance, and financing mechanisms.
