

#### Data and evidence – Introduction

- The number of research articles on displacement in economics exploded after 2010.
- A similar trend can be observed also in other disciplines
- But gaps persist, in production and use of data and evidence.





#### Data and Evidence – The Goal

- Expand quality data and evidence, disaggregated by age and sex at a minimum, to promote effective programmes and policies for economic inclusion and social protection that integrates the perspectives and needs of refugees, other forcibly displaced and stateless people, and host communities.
- Over the next four years, research will be undertaken to address key evidence and knowledge gaps identified through existing efforts and agendas on self-reliance, economic inclusion, and social protection.



## Data and Evidence – Impact Indicators

- 1. Amount of monetary investment provided for research related to socio-economic inclusion and social protection law, policy, and programming.
- 2. Number of research or data collection projects or initiatives linked to identified research priorities on self-reliance, economic inclusion, and social protection.
- 3. Number of analytical products on self-reliance, economic inclusion, and social protection that integrate refugees' perspectives and needs.
- 4. Number of refugee-led research or evidence products produced on self-reliance, economic inclusion, and social protection topics.



### Data and Evidence – A few examples

- **(Donor)** pledges to grant XXX over a YYY months/ years for individuals and institutions conducting research on economic inclusion and social protection, including to support ZZZ refugee-led research initiatives or collaborations that include researchers with lived displacement experience.
- *(Member state)* commits to include refugees, other forcibly displaced and stateless people, including displaced children and their families in sector analyses, plans and budgets, data analysis and evidence generation processes.
- (Research institution) pledges to complete XXX research projects or initiatives that support data and evidence gaps articulated by state actors to facilitate law and policy reform efforts
